During the summer, you and your child can prepare for the first day of school by obtaining the necessary items on the Sixth Grade Supply List.

- 6 spiral notebooks (100-120 sheets)

- 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
- 1 pencil case or small box for supplies
- 4 packs college rule paper (without plastic-hole edge)
- erasers
- 1 pair safety scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pocket dictionary
- 1 pocket thesaurus
- 1 sturdy book bag or back pack (wheels are acceptable)
- 1 packages 3x5 lined index cards
- 5 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 personal size scotch tape
- 1 reading book to keep in desk for silent reading
- 3 packages of graph paper for math class
- 2 container Lysol wipes

For Computer Class:

- 1 two pocket folder
- college rule paper
- 1 set of headphones

For Art Class:

- 1 bottle “Kraft-style” liquid glue
- 1 extra fine black Sharpie

For Science Class::

- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 two pocket folder
- 1 9” x 11” dry erase board
- 1 set dry erase pens
