In order to help you prepare for the first day of school, I am giving you the supply list for Seventh Grade now. **Each student should bring the following items to school the first day:**

- small pencil sharpener
- scotch tape
- 2 **non-erasable** blue or black pens
- 2 **non-erasable** red pens

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- dry white out tape (optional) ****no liquid white out**
- 1 pencil box for small supplies
- Supply of stretchy book covers for all books
